The Sutherlin-Oakland Emergency Food Panty can accept food donations past the “expiration date” stamped on the food can or other packaging. The Food Pantry’s Director, Richard Jorge, called after last week’s issue of the Log was published, saying that it could not.

Mr. George said that his staff is trained to accept and inspect such items, so long as there are no indications of deterioration of the food items or the packaging (for example rust on cans). They will take care of discarding items that must be rejected.

Our on-line research confirmed that there is a lot of confusion as to what the date stamping means and that most food can be safely used well beyond the dates. So, put those items in the bin in the Timber Valley club house and we’ll let the Food Pantry decide.
