

WHAT SHOULD I DO WITH MOM OR DAD'S STUFF?



We at Timber Valley understand how difficult it is to dispose of Mom or Dad's stuff and we would like to help by providing a few suggestions on how to dispose of items.

Although you may think we can use some of these items, the truth is we all have more stuff than we need.

When cleaning out Mom or Dad's rig here are a few suggestions:

- Donation table in the Clubhouse
 1. Clean usable household items in working condition are acceptable.
 2. Clean clothing and shoes.
 3. Small electronic items only. Must be in working order.
 4. NO prescription medicines – The Sutherlin Police Department at 126 E. Central Avenue accepts medicines for proper disposal.
 5. NO flammable materials i.e. charcoal lighter, cigarette lighters, etc.
 6. NO alcohol.

- Food pantry – donations of unopened non-perishable food are always welcome for our local food pantry. There is a box in the clubhouse dining room for donations. Donations can also be taken directly to the Sutherlin/Oakland food pantry at 183 E. First Avenue, Sutherlin, OR. The hours of operation are Mondays and Wednesdays from 9 a.m. – 11 a.m. (541) 459-4082
