

## Addendum #02 to Park-wide Directive of April 13, 2020

### **Subject: Self -Quarantine.**

During the COVID -19 Pandemic, and pendency of the Oregon Governor's Executive Order No. 20-12, these temporary Timber Valley Park Restrictions shall be followed:

All Leaseholders returning to the Park, after being out of the Park, for a period exceeding 24 hours, are required to Self-Quarantine for a period of 14 days. If only one member is out of the Park for over 24 hours, the co-occupant need not self-quarantine. All renters are required to Self-Quarantine for a period of 14 days from the date of entering the Park.

Persons under Self-Quarantine must observe the following rules:

1. Stay on your RV site as much as practical. If you must leave your site, practice strict social distancing, i.e.. A distance of at least six (6) feet from others.
2. Do not enter the Park's laundry room.
3. Do not invite anyone to your site.
4. If you must interact with park employees. let them know you are under self-quarantine.
5. If self-quarantined persons must visit another lot, they should wear facemasks and must inform others that they are self-quarantined.
6. Members on self-quarantine can walk around the Park and work on individual tasks that can be done while maintaining social distancing. They can operate a mower or work on individual landscaping tasks, for example, but should wear facemasks and must maintain strict social distancing. Such Members must also inform others that they are self-quarantined.
7. Guests: If a friend or relative who is not a Park resident comes to visit you, your guest must follow the pertinent self-quarantine rules while in the Park, but the resident Member is not required to self-quarantine because of the visit.
8. If both members of a co-occupancy Membership travel away from the Park to a location outside of Douglas County, those Members must self-quarantine upon their return.

Obeying these rules will help protect your fellow SKP's and allow Timber Valley to continue to remain open, to serve the needs of its leaseholders and the Escapees community.
