Hello, my name is Amber AKA Puddy Tat

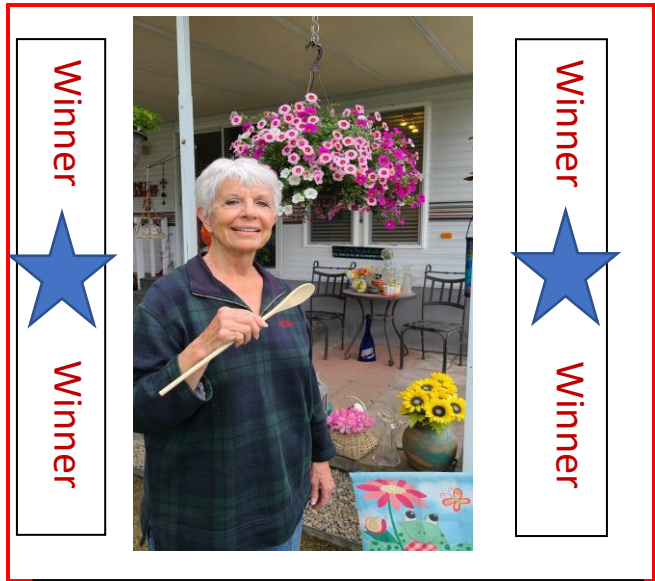

RULES AND REGULATION REMINDER

Only 1 inhabited RV per lot is allowed.

An uninhabited RV is allowed on the lot for a maximum of 48 hours in any 7 consecutive days for the purpose of loading/unloading contents. If you need additional time, please contact our TV park manager, Randy.

A second recreational vehicle is only allowed on the lot from November 1st to April 1st for winter care.

A small boat may be kept on a lot from April 1st to November 1st. If, it is being used for fishing or recreation.
