The monthly Agenda Meeting is the answer. The Agenda Meeting is the meeting that *makes* the agenda for the monthly Board Meeting. The Agenda meeting is held the 2nd Thursday of every month (one week before the actual Board Meeting). It is an informal workshop style meeting, where anyone there is encouraged to speak and be part of the process of the park. You interact with the board - and all parties get to know each other and share ideas and opinions.

In a typical meeting any correspondence addressed to the Board is read and a decision is made as to the next step - should it go to the office or a committee to handle or should it be placed on the agenda or is it a simple matter that can be answered right then. Then Board members can raise topics they think might need to be on the agenda, followed by any other participating members - that could be you if you are there.

This meeting, in my opinion (ahem), is about the best in the Park. I have learned so much about what kind of issues are on members minds, how the Board members interact with each other and with the members, how decisions are made on different subjects. I have come to appreciate just how much work is involved in running this Park and how diverse our membership is in thoughts and ideas. The Board members have a *lot to do* and they are volunteers.

The Agenda meeting is held the 2nd Thursday of every month at 9am in the meeting room of the clubhouse. If you're in the Park you might want to consider attending.
