ELECTION COMMITTEE - DATES TO REMEMBER 2023 / 2024 BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION

March 16	The Board of Directors issued a directive to the Election Committee to begin the recruiting process for Board members in the 2023/2024 election process
March 22	Office Manager and Election Committee Chair and Co-Chair met to prepare calendar for 2023/2024 calendar year
April 12	Letters mailed and Posters placed at the clubhouse and office announcing the recruitment for Board members for the 2023/2024 fiscal year
May 3	Remove recruitment posters
May 5	Applicant resumes and photos for new Board member positions due in office by 5:00 pm today
May 10	Election Committee planning meeting - 3:00 pm
May 15	Prepare envelopes; get ballots ready for mailing. 1:00 pm
May 16	Ballots mailed
July 7	All ballots must be in the office by 5:00 pm (cut off date must be at least 45 days from mail out date: May - 15 days; June 30 days; July - 7 day

July 17	Count ballots - 1:00 pm
July 20	Inform Board of Directors of results of ballot count
July 25	Announce results of election at Annual Meeting
