The Board will hold a closed discussion only meeting to further understand and address the members concerns, letters, rules and policies on the Tuesday before the Board Meeting. This meeting is held off-site and has proven to be productive.

The third Thursday of the month is the Board Meeting. This meeting is for the Board to discuss and make decisions on how to handle rules, policies and concerns of the members. The Board will be discussing and handling the aforementioned items. Eight members of the Board will be voting on any motions made at this meeting. The President cannot make a motion and can only vote if there is a tie. This is a Board meeting and there is no input from the members unless called on by a Board Member.

Letters written to the Board should be received by the Secretary by the Tuesday before the Workshop. If you write a letter to the Board, we ask that you be present at the Agenda Workshop and at the Board Meeting. The Board may ask you to discuss your concerns and/or requests.

Both meetings are held in the clubhouse big room at 9 a.m.
