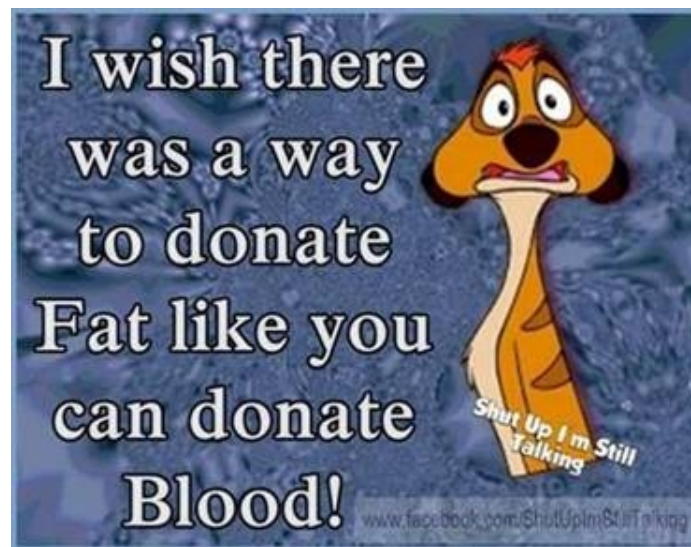
CORRECT YOUR CALENDAR FOR CHAPTER 9 OUTING

BULLETIN BOARDS IN TIMBER VALLEY
