#### How much water do we use?

Are you aware that a small team of Timber Valley members monitors our water use? Special technology allows us to record daily use amounts, numbers that go back more than five years. This data has been invaluable in getting early warnings on large leaks, saving us many dollars in wasted water. It has also been used to demonstrate to the city that much of our summer high water use is irrigation, again saving us many dollars. The city of Sutherlin so appreciates our data that they use it to cross-check their meter reader accuracy.

Our water use is logged in a graph on our Website every week. This graph shows our current use and compares it with use during the same period the previous three years. It's on the Members Only page. Scroll down to find it and check it out. Good, interesting information.
