

## **Water Usage**

Did you know that Timber Valley monitors our park water use? Well, we do...We have our daily water use numbers, going back over 5 years! We have a small team that uses technology to obtain these daily numbers. This has been invaluable in getting early "warning" on large leaks, saving us many dollars in wasted water. The city of Sutherlin is so impressed with this that they use our data to cross-check their meter reader accuracy. In addition, this data has been used to convince the city that much of our high summer water use is irrigation, again saving us many dollars.

Our water use is presented in a graph on our Website, and is updated weekly. This graph shows our current use, as well as comparing this use with the same period in the previous 3 years. This graph is located on the Members Only page...just scroll down to find it. Check it out, quite interesting.
