This was a fascinating Q & A session, where attendees asked pertinent questions from most frequent calls (theft and domestic assault), average number of calls per day (30), best practices if getting pulled over when driving (you may be asked to exit your vehicle and move to a safe area of the road for everyone's safety), freeway driving laws (left lane is for passing), request to do a ride-along (yes), and impact of Hastings Village (helpful).
