

## 🎤 Social Hour - Friday July 5 @ 3pm - Dining Room 🎤

Enjoy snacks, a glass of wine or bring your own beverage! Speaker to be announced.

In case you missed last week's Social Hour, over 20 attendees enjoyed a presentation and flying demonstration on radio-controlled (RC) aircraft by Timber Valley's own Ken Walker! Enthusiasts like Ken build custom RC aircraft from scratch or using kits, experimenting with different designs and technologies. Ken explained that crashes teach you about flying, and that construction materials perform differently after a crash. Balsa wood planes require replacing parts after a crash, and Ken's wife Glenda described a crashed balsa wood plane as a pile of toothpicks! Foam aircraft are easiest to repair post-crash using superglue or hot glue.

Some aircraft use one pint of gas for propulsion and can fly up to 20 minutes, while others use lithium batteries and can fly from 5 to 10 minutes. The cost of RC aircraft can be as reasonable as \$250 for a plane, \$250-\$300 for a controller, and a few hundred dollars if the pilot wishes to add a camera.

Unlike drones, which have a return to home feature on the controller allowing the pilot to bring the drone back with the push of a button, RC aircraft controllers do not know which way the plane is heading and thus require active directional flying by the pilot.



We also watched an entertaining 10 minutes YouTube video called So YOU Want To Fly RC Planes (<https://shorturl.at/nb4O3>), giving us a feel for what is involved in building and flying RC aircraft.

Plat I Float Fly is an RC flying event every June at Plat I and is free of charge for spectators.
