### What's wrong with this picture?

Randy recently salvaged this lawn furniture from the burn pile, prompting this reminder that anything added to the burn pile must actually burn. That means fresh scrap wood, weathered wood, or trimmings from bushes or hedges. Do not leave metal (like the swing in this picture), plastics, tires, batteries (car, RV or household), or anything explosive. Take these items to Sutherlin Sanitary Services when appropriate, recycle them or discard them responsibly. If you have questions about the burn pile, check with the park office. The office also has a complete list of recycling locations they'll be glad to share.
