🎃 Spooktacular Halloween Party Recap! 🧛

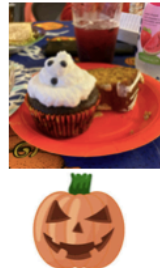

Preparing for Winter

Although we live in a mild climate, hard freezes can happen here!

Be prepared:

1. Cover water hose. Similar to pool noodle are insulated tubes that are pre-sliced lengthwise that will fit over your hose, (available at Lowes/Home Depot). Tuck as much as you can under your RV, and cover the entire length. Consider a heated hose.

2. Check sewer hose for dips. Lay out flat with slight downward tilt. Any area with liquid may freeze and cause stinky problems.

3. Change heater filters, clean vent covers.

4. Setup your dehumidifier. Moisture is an RVs nightmare.

5. Fill propane tanks.
