In Case You Missed It:

Social Hour Speaker Friday November 22 - Rusty and Elena Lininger of HealTerra**

HealTerra, a social enterprise under Source One Serenity, helps veterans find purpose through outdoor activities like hiking and fly-fishing. Founded in 2016 by Rusty and Elena Lininger, it expanded in 2017 to include vermicomposting, using worms to turn food waste into nutrient-rich compost. We learned that the best worms for vermicomposting are red wigglers (*Eisenia fetida*) which are 3-4 inches long.



HealTerra has grown into a thriving veteran-employed operation, raising funds for expansion, receiving several grants, and **diverting over 5 tons of food waste since 2021**. Their worm digester processes up to 100 yards of food waste annually.

HealTerra partners with local groups like Umpqua Valley Farm to School and the Rosburg VA Medical Center to collect food waste. HealTerra offered to provide us with compost for the garden if we collect our food waste!
