Large Items in the Dumpster

We've noticed some large items being placed in our dumpsters. When this happens, it takes extra time and effort from our volunteers and staff—time that could otherwise go into the daily work and projects that make Timber Valley such a great place to live.

For everyone's convenience, here's a reminder from the Timber Valley Rules & Regulations (posted under Governing Documents in the Members Only section of the website):



GARBAGE AND TRASH DISPOSAL:

- 1. Garbage: Garbage in securely tied plastic bags shall be deposited in dumpsters located near the dump station for collection. Sutherlin Municipal Code number 8,20.050 J prohibits dumping hazardous waste such as tires, motor oil, auto batteries, oil filters or electronic devices or parts of in the dumpsters. Violation may be fined up to \$1,000. (08/28/00; 10/08/08; 03/13/14)
- 2. Composting shall be allowed in an enclosed container on individual lots, providing there are no complaints regarding odors. (04/29/92)
- 3. For the enjoyment of all, do not litter. All trash, including cigarette butts, shall be discarded in appropriate containers. Let's keep our park clean and attractive. (02/17/05; 03/13/14)

If you have large items, Douglas County has 11 transfer stations (Roseburg, Reedsport, Myrtle Creek, Canyonville, Glide, Yoncalla, Glendale, Elkton, Camas Valley, Tiller, and Oakland). These facilities accept general waste and recycling (some restrictions apply).
