Clean corrugated cardboard only. (example - shipping boxes)

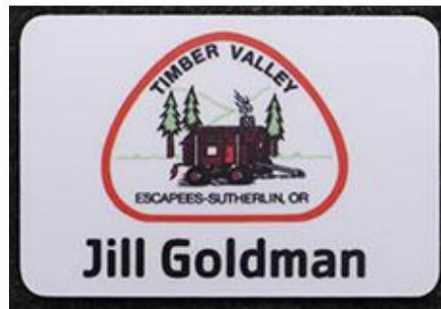
