Clubhouse Cleaning

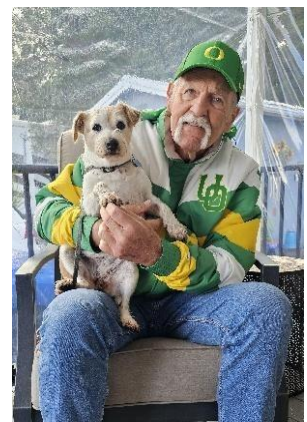
