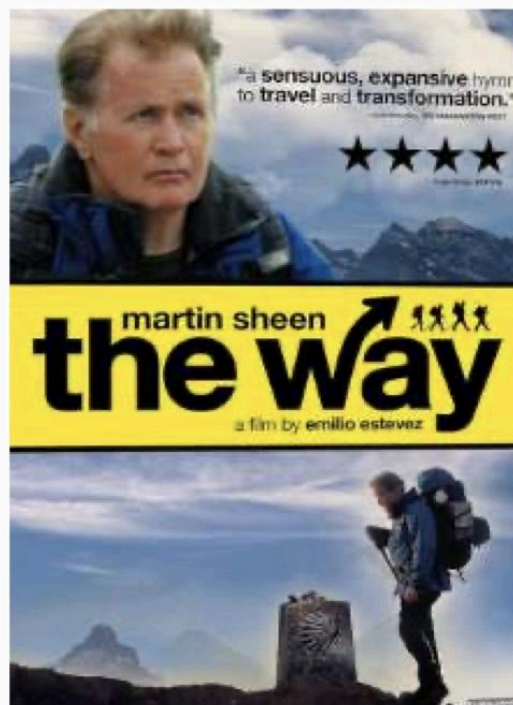

Why We Do the Monday Radio Roll Call

Recently, a loud sound in one area of the park caught the attention of nearby residents. Several residents quickly checked in on Channel 6, shared information, and investigated and clarified the situation.

This was a small example of something we have seen before. During the January 21, 2025 power outage, radio communication allowed neighbors to share updates, coordinate propane support and device-charging, and offer help before power was restored. In both situations, timely radio check-ins helped keep neighbors informed and at ease.

Events like these remind us how valuable it can be to know how to use our radios and hear familiar voices. The Monday Radio Roll Call is a relaxed, friendly check-in that takes about 10 minutes and helps everyone stay comfortable using their radios. Join us Mondays at 4pm on FRS/GMRS (walkie-talkie) Channel 6. Even listening in helps keep our community connected and prepared.
