What are those wires on the Clubhouse Roof?

Brought to you by your Emergency Preparedness Committee

Has anyone noticed the new “wire” on the Clubhouse roof and wondered what is that wire is used for? This wire is part of the Emergency Preparedness Committee communications system that will be invaluable in a true emergency. This wire is a 126-foot-long wire antenna that covers many of the higher Ham Radio bands and will allow voice communication nearly worldwide in an Emergency.

There are two other smaller antennas mounted to the chimney on the Clubhouse. One is used for our walkie talkie based (FRS/GMRS) park communication system that is tested every Monday at 4PM. If you are not part of this you are hereby invited to grab your walkie talkie (that you probably already own) and listen in on channel #6.... Everyone is invited.... It's fun.

The other antenna is a Ham Radio antenna that covers a lower band than the long wire antenna.

All these antennas work off the base station located inside the Clubhouse. This base station is in the is in the process of being configured with 12v back-up power recharged by solar, so it will function even without 120v power.

This Ham Radio system, coupled with Starlink systems, and SMS txt messaging will have Timber Valley well positioned to communicate during a major emergency.
