

Generator Help

Brought to you by your Emergency Preparedness Committee

There are many portable generators in our park. This is a very good way to be prepared for long-lasting power outages, like “Snowmageddon” that lasted 4 days. How many of our generator owners have the strength to haul them out of storage, start them, or do the necessary maintenance? We suspect there are many of our folks that cannot. If you fit this description for any reason, then your generator needs a “generator buddy”! This is right out of the neighbors helping neighbors’ idea that Escapees and this park advocate for.

The time to find a “generator buddy” is BEFORE an emergency happens. This person should be a close contact that could understand your generator needs and can physically help you with your generator in an emergency. Some people have even discussed “sharing” a generator and running heavy duty extension cords between two lots.

The best way to understand your generator is to locate the operation / maintenance manual...either a hard copy or on-line. Ensure the recommended maintenance is performed and test run it on a regular schedule. I started my generator the other day, after sitting for maybe 6 months. It was hard to start, so I plan on making it a monthly activity.
