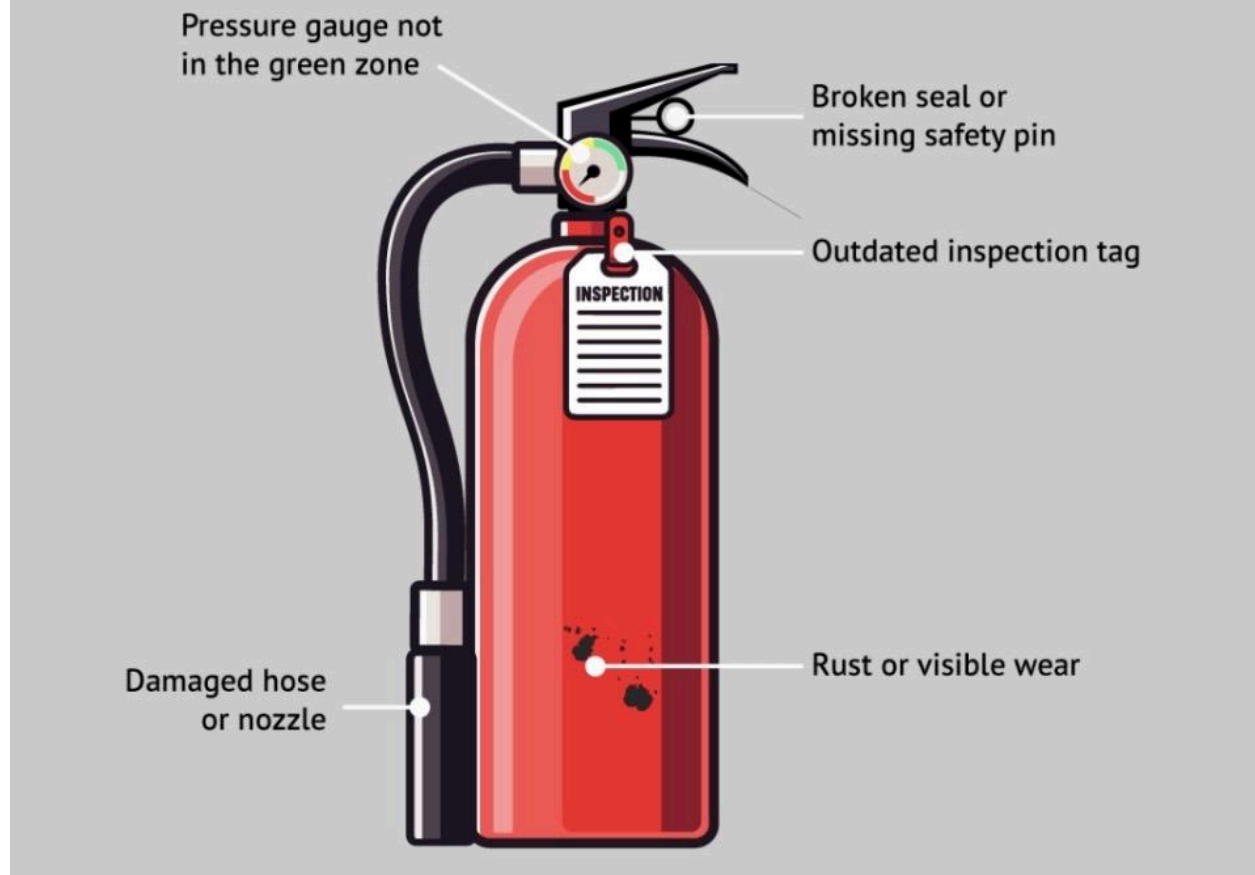

## How to Tell If a Fire Extinguisher Is Expired or Unsafe to Use



**When was the last time you thought about your Fire Extinguisher? If you're like me, it has been hanging on the wall near your door, and you walk pass it every day without looking at it!**

**Fire Extinguishers are required to be installed in every RV. They do not last forever. Here is how to tell if yours can be counted on in an emergency:**

**They come in many types, but what is most often recommended is a multi-purpose dry chemical extinguisher labeled ABC. This type puts out most all types of fires. This is most likely what you have.**

We all hope you never need to use yours, but if you do, here is a simple way to remember  
how to use it...**PASS**

**PULL:** Pull the pin

**AIM:** Aim the nozzle or horn at the base of the fire

**SQUEEZE:** Squeeze or press the handle

**SWEEP:** Sweep from side to side at the base of the fire until it goes out. Shut off the fire extinguisher and watch for any reflash. Reactivate the fire extinguisher if required.

*Always remember to dial 911*
