Games begin at 6:30pm Popcorn will be served. Soda and Ice cream are available.

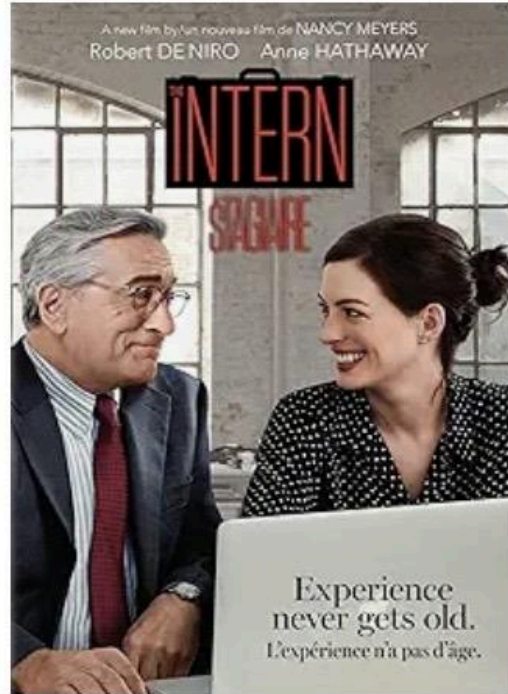
