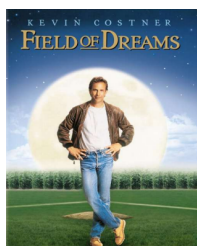
Chapter 9 Lunch and Museum Tour - Wednesday June 10 @ 11:30am - Roseburg

Timber Valley Reminders

Welcome to our summer season! The news is full of warnings about how dry this recent winter was, and how extreme this fire season could be. This summer's fire season started on May 30, about a week earlier than any in the previous 5 years! In last weeks Log you read about wildfire smoke...we sure hope to avoid that this summer.

Timber Valley provides two important reminders that we all need to consider. Each of these are displayed as conditions warrant. Please take notice as you drive in and out of our park.

- 1) **A Red Flag posted on the end of the Reader Board:** This means that a Red Flag warning has been issued by Douglas Co. This does not mean there is a fire, but does mean that conditions are such that if a fire does start it can spread quickly due to factors such as high winds, low humidity, and dry vegetation.
 - Avoid outdoor burning or any activity that could create sparks
 - Use extra caution with grills, propane equipment, and generators
 - Do not park vehicles on dry grass
 - Secure loose items that could be affected by strong winds
 - Stay alert for emergency messages and changing conditions

- 2) **A sign by the Reader Board: HOT DAYS ARE HERE CONSERVE ELECTRIC.** This goes hand-in-hand with high temperatures and is requested to reduce "strain" on the overall utility grid and Timber Valley's electrical grid
