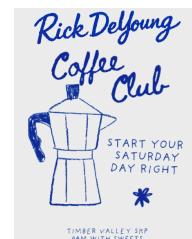
Social Hour Speaker - Friday June 19 @ 3pm - Dining Room

High temperatures and increased energy use can sometimes lead to power outages. Even short outages during hot weather can affect comfort and safety. A little preparation can help you stay safe until power is restored:

- Keep flashlights and extra batteries in easy-to-find locations.
- Have a battery-powered or hand-crank radio for updates.
- Keep a small supply of shelf-stable food and water.
- Avoid opening the refrigerator frequently to keep food cold longer.
- Plan how to stay cool, such as moving to a shaded or cooler area if needed.
