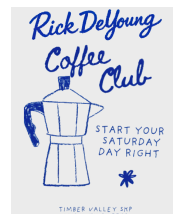

Emergency Alerts: Are You Signed Up?

During a wildfire, severe weather event, or other emergency, timely information can make all the difference.

All Timber Valley residents are encouraged to sign up for **TV Alerts**, our park's emergency notification system. Instructions are available on the Members Only page of the website. Renters may sign up through the office.

Residents should also ensure they are registered with **Douglas Alerts**, the county and City of Sutherlin official emergency notification system. Douglas Alerts provides important information about evacuations, wildfires, severe weather, and other emergencies that may affect our area.
