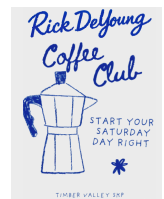

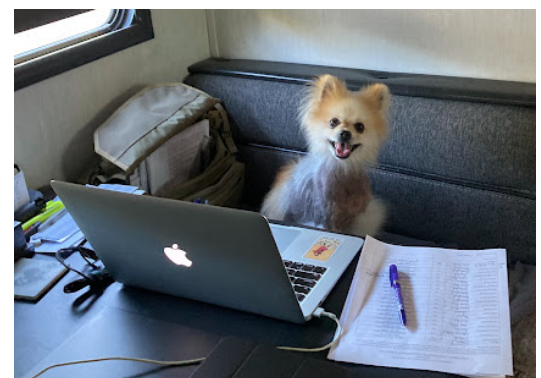
This is NOT a Committee, and there are NO meetings! So, if you expressed interest in non-Committee volunteer work, this might be for you.
