Emergency Prep This Week: Will the Pets Cooperate?

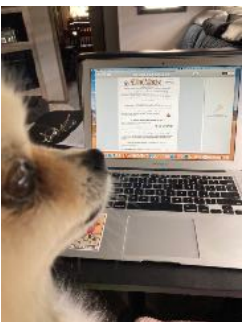
